## **Report of Doctoral Comprehensive Examinations**

The Plan of Study, including the supervisory committee, must be approved by the Graduate College before a student is eligible to take the doctoral comprehensive examinations.

All results, including failure in any one of the required examinations, will be reported. Failure in the comprehensive exam is considered final unless the student petitions for a re-examination, the committee and the Graduate Program Chair make the recommendation, and the Graduate College approves the re-examination. A re-examination may be administered no sooner than three months and no later than one year from the date of the original examination. Furthermore, a student cannot proceed to the next portion until they have successfully passed the current one.
